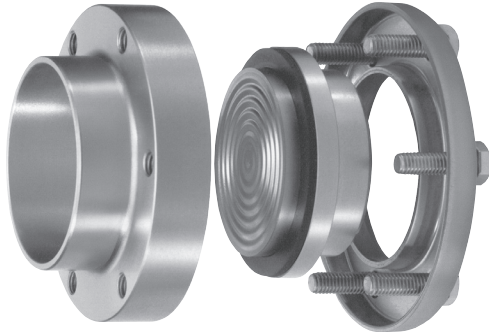


Diaphragm seal 1020

for the paper industry



Main Features

- Wetted parts stainless steel 1.4571 (316Ti) and 1.4435 (316L)
- Standard connection for the paper industry

Applications

- Paper industry

Description

This diaphragm seals are used to protect pressure gauges from high temperatures, aggressive or corrosive fluids.

They avoid that the medium flows into the instrument, where deposits could be built and generate wrong measurements or pollution of the process.

Chemical seals can be mounted to mechanical pressure gauges, switches or transmitters directly or with a cooling element. The filling fluid of the measuring system has to be chosen compatible to the application.

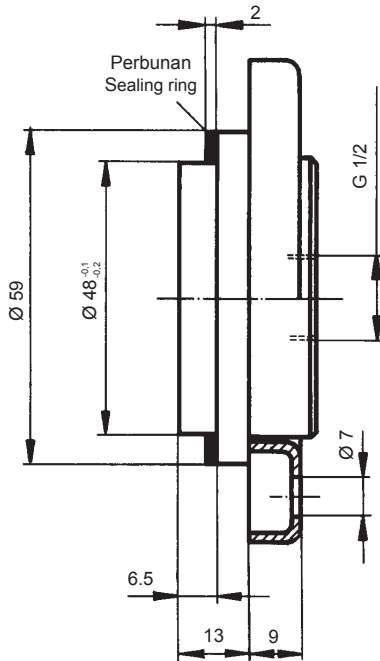

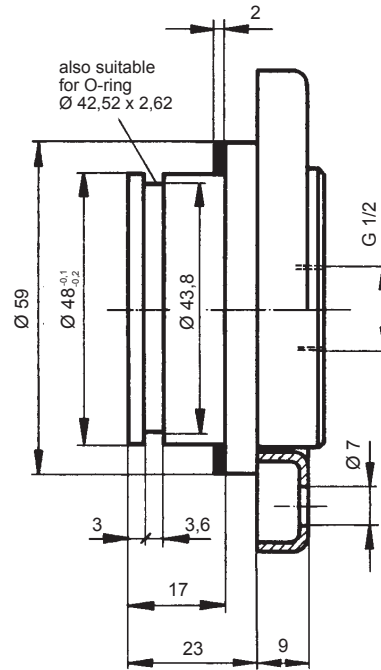
The gasket is included in the delivery of the diaphragm seal.

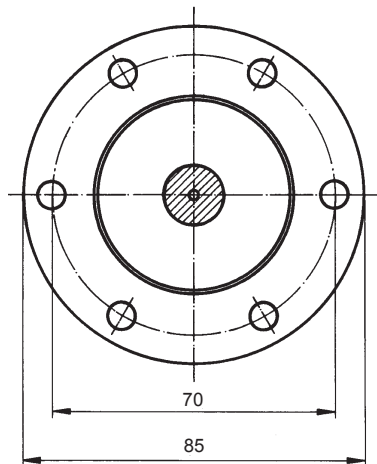
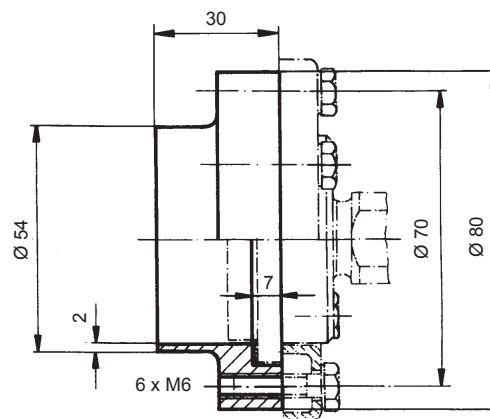
Standard version (code 1020)
